A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT \$8,500.00 OF FUNDING FROM THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ASSOCIATION (NEHA) THROUGH THE RETAIL FLEXIBLE FUNDING MODEL (RFFM) GRANT PROGRAM TO BE ADMINISTERED BY LOUISVILLE METRO PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELLNESS.

WHEREAS, the Retail Flexible Funding Model (RFFM) grant program provides strategies for prevention-base food safety to reduce foodborne illness; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to assist retail food programs in their efforts to reduce the occurrence of foodborne illness risk factors and implement and attain conformance with Retail Program Standards; and

WHEREAS, the Metro Government wishes to take advantage of this opportunity through Louisville Metro Public Health and Wellness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept \$8,500.00 of funding from the National Environment Health Association through the Retail Flexible Funding Model grant program to be administered by Louisville Metro Public Health and Wellness.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
