A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT \$1,834,829.00 OF FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE THROUGH THE COMMUNITY BASED VIOLENCE INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION INITIATIVE GRANT PROGRAM TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE OFFICE FOR SAFE AND HEALTHY NEIGHBORHOODS.

SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBER BRENT ACKERSON

WHEREAS, the Community Based Violence Intervention and Prevention grant program provides resources, leadership, and solutions to advance community safety, build community trust, and strengthen the community's role as co-producer of safety and justices; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to expand the number of Cure Violence Intervention and Interruption sites, expand the in-house outreach case management team, and to consolidate gun violence reduction strategies into a scaled down neighborhood approach; and

WHEREAS, the Metro Government wishes to take advantage of this opportunity through the Office for Safe and Healthy Neighborhoods.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept \$1,834,829.00 of funding from The Office of Justice grant program, to be administered by the Office for Safe and Healthy Neighborhoods.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
