
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION I: The sum of ~~\$30,000~~ ~~\$50,000~~ \$54,500 is hereby appropriated from ~~District 23~~ Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$30,000 from District 23; AND \$20,000 from District 24; \$2,000 from District 22; \$1,000 from District 8; and \$500 each from Districts 9, 17, and 21; to Metro Parks for production costs of the 2025 FridayFest in Highview Park concert series.


SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.



Dear Metro Council Clerk Harward,

I am requesting to amend Ordinance Number 231, Series 2024. The title of the ordinance is:

An Ordinance Appropriating \$54,500 from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$30,000 from District 23; \$20,000 from District 24; \$2,000 from District 22, \$1,000 from District 8; and \$500 each from districts 9, 17, and 21; to Metro Parks for productions costs of the 2025 FridayFest in Highview Park Concert Series.

The original request was for \$60,000 and that has not changed. The full funding is still needed to produce the concert series. My intention was to add the remaining funds at the Council Meeting where it received final passage. I would like to correct this and to add an additional \$5,500 from District 23 Neighborhood Development Funds.
