**WHEREAS**, this funding will be used to develop ambitious plans for reducing greenhouse gas emissions and other harmful air pollution and qualify Metro to apply for additional implementation grants; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept \$1,000,000 from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) through the Climate Pollution Reduction Grants program to be administered by the Office of Sustainability.

**SECTION II:** This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
