AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ~~\$42,000~~ \$60,000 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$12,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 9, 13, 15, AND 17; AND \$6,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 8 AND 16; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO BRIGHTSIDE FOUNDATION, INC. FOR THE PUBLIC DISPLAY OF GALLOPALOOZA HORSE STATUES IN DISTRICTS 8, 9, 13, 15, 16, AND 17 (AS AMENDED).


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION I: The sum of ~~\$42,000~~ \$60,000 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$12,000 each from Districts 9, 13, 15, and 17; and \$6,000 each from Districts 8 and 16; through the Office of Management and Budget, to Brightside Foundation, Inc. for the public display of GallopaLooza horse statues in Districts 8, 9, 13, 15, 16, and 17.


SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.


