**Due to the heavy traffic flow along Blanton Lane in front of proposed Oak tree removal. Traffic control will need to be implemented because of limited work area and utility lines that pass through canopy of trees. Traffic @ times will need to be suspended for safety. LG&E will need to cover electric lines with insulated blankets due to close proximity to tree.

We propose to furnish material, labor and equipment to complete work in accordance with above specifications. Hello CM Blackwell and Liz-

I am reaching out concerning a dangerous tree in the public right of way at 4009 Blanton Lane. The Division received a complaint about the tree that lead us to inspection. We determined that the large oak tree is 90% percent dead with a hollow base truck. Additionally, the tree has several limbs with cracks that could lead to failure. They could break and fall on the street or the house. The Division contacted the property owner, Maria Thomas, via a notification letter that explained her responsibilities as the property owner and that the tree needs to be removed to protect public safety. Mrs. Thomas has received cost estimate and explained to the Division because she cannot afford to remove the tree. We have checked with the local utility company (LG&E) to see if this is something that they need to address to protect the utility line adjacent to the tree and they have already trimmed as needed.

Is it possible for CD 12 to offer Mrs. Thomas assistance? Please let me know and I will get a cost estimate from the city contractor.
