**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT \$165,197 OF FUNDING FROM THE KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT FOR PUBLIC HEALTH THROUGH THE OFFICE OF HEALTH EQUITY FOR STRENGTHENING EQUITABLE ACCESS TO HEALTHCARE SERVICES, RESULTING IN OPTIMAL HEALTH OUTCOMES AND THE REDUCTION OF HEALTHCARE SYSTEM BARRIERS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Office of Health Equity Education grant provides funding to address health disparities among racial and ethnic minorities providing comprehensive, sustained, community-based health equity; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds will be used to provide inclusive access to health services by partnering with The Office of Health Equity for vaccine and health education; and

**WHEREAS**, Metro Government wishes to take advantage of this opportunity through the Department of Public Health and Wellness.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept \$165,197 of funding from the Office of Health Equity, OHE Health Education grant to provide equitable access to health and social service to marginalized communities.

**SECTION II:** This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
