In 2006 there was another high crime wave that occurred in our community. We introduced C.A.R.E. , a faith-based initiative involving churches to anonymously report crime tips to LMPD from area residents.

We'd like to revisit that effort in hope of reducing and/or preventing further crimes in Louisville Kentucky.

The plan is for residents of the community to call a local church anonymously with a crime tip and the church forward that information anonymously , to the police 574- LMPD (574-5673) hotline .

Statistics kept by LMPD in 2006 , showed a reduction in crime. Because of this program. Residents were no longer afraid to speak up about crimes they may have witnessed.

This effort was created by Prevention 2000, inc. a children's crime prevention program created by Donnie Morris Sr , retired Judge Toni Stringer and daughter Donniesha Green.

In addition, we've talked to C.L.O.U.T. and their group of churches to expand the effort. Also, we will be distributing booklets of city services in hope that residents will find organizations that may be helpful in the prevention crime before they occur.
