A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT \$12,000.00 OF FUNDING FROM THE KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT FOR PUBLIC HEALTH THROUGH THE PUBLIC NALOXONE STORAGE BOXES GRANT PROGRAM TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELLNESS.

WHEREAS, the KDPH grant program is responsible for developing, operating, and improving the health and safety of communities through prevention, promotion and protection.; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to purchase Naloxone Storage Boxes and funding for personnel time to host community focus groups to discuss overdose prevention, access to naloxone, and to determine the placement of Naloxone Storage Boxes throughout their respective communities.

WHEREAS, the Metro Government wishes to take advantage of this opportunity through the Department of Public Health and Wellness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept \$12,000.00 of funding from The Kentucky Department for Public Health grant program, to be administered by the Department of Public Health and Wellness.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
