

ORDINANCE NO. _____, SERIES 2024

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$13,300 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$6,650 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 17 AND 18; TO THE LOUISVILLE METRO POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR TWO FLOCK CAMERAS FOR THE CITY OF ANCHORAGE.

SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBER PARKER AND PRESIDENT WINKLER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (“THE COUNCIL”) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$13,300 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$6,650 each from Districts 17 and 18; to the Louisville Metro Police Department for two flock cameras for the City of Anchorage.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council’s Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
