Two (2) Speed humps x \$4,200.00 =	\$8,400.00
Two (2) Speed hump Signs x \$260.00 =	\$520.00
Total =	\$8,920.00

Please consider this letter as our official statement of cost for all speed hump related work. Each speed hump, including markings is \$4,200.00 and each sign is \$260.00. Based on our engineering studies, a total of two (2) speed humps and two (2) speed hump signs have been proposed for Woodbourne Avenue, between Bardstown Road and Wibben Avenue. The total "not to exceed" cost is \$8,920.00.


Upon funding approval, the speed humps will be installed as schedule and weather permits.
