A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT \$400,000 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY BUILDING TECHNOLOGIES OFFICE (BTO) THROUGH THE BUILDINGS UP GRANTS PROGRAM TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE OFFICE OF SUSTAINABILITY.

WHEREAS, the Buildings Upgrade Prize (Buildings UP) is a U.S. Department of Energy prize designed to build capacity to accelerate equitable, widespread energy efficiency and efficient electrification building upgrades across the country; and


WHEREAS, this funding will be used to help transform U.S. buildings into energy-efficient and clean energy-ready homes, commercial spaces, and communities; and

WHEREAS, the Metro Government wishes to take advantage of this opportunity through the Office of Sustainability.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept \$400,000 from The U.S. Department of Energy Building Technologies Office (BTO) through the Buildings Up Grants program to be administered by the Office of Sustainability.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
