Summary of testimony of those in favor:

01:56:53 Mr. Bardenwerper stated he has been with this project since day one. The homeowners' association is initiating this project to help pay for what they now own. There will be a liquor license for the entire facility, but will also require a CUP for the outdoor sales and consumption.

02:03:14 Mr. Nash said the lease is still being finalized – 5 years with a 5 year extension. "They've committed to a 3 year pay period on the lease regardless of what happens to the facility."
