

ORDINANCE NO. _____, SERIES 2024

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ~~\$1,500~~ ~~\$5,000~~ \$7,000 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$1,500 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 2 AND 6; \$750 FROM DISTRICT 3; AND \$500 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 8, 12, 21, AND 24; AND \$250 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 1, 9, 13, 14, AND 17; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO FAMILY SCHOLAR HOUSE, INC. FOR THEIR PACK A BACKPACK BASH PROVIDING SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR FAMILY SCHOLAR HOUSE SCHOLARS (AS AMENDED).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of ~~\$1,500~~ ~~\$5,000~~ \$7,000 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development funds in the following manner: \$1,500 each from Districts 2 and 6; \$750 from District 3; and \$500 each from Districts 8, 12, 21, and 24; and \$250 each from Districts 1, 9, 13, 14, and 17; through the Office of Management and Budget, to Family Scholar House, Inc. for their Pack a Backpack Bash providing school supplies for Family Scholar House scholars.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
