**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$6,300 FROM DISTRICT 20 NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS TO THE LOUISVILLE METRO POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR ONE FLOCK CAMERA TO BE PLACED AT THE ENTRANCE TO WOODED LAKE NEIGHBORHOOD.**

**SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBER BENSON**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (“THE COUNCIL”) AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The sum of \$6,300 from District 20 Neighborhood Development Funds to the Louisville Metro Police Department for one Flock camera to be placed at the entrance to Wooded Lake Neighborhood.

**SECTION II:** The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

**SECTION III:** This grant is subject to the Council’s Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

**SECTION IV:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
