Whereas, Seventeen-year-old DeSales High School student Brandon Malone displayed remarkable, selfless courage and quick thinking when he took immediate action to rescue them; and

Whereas, Brandon, swiftly brought one of the girls to safety, then turned his attention to the other young lady located further out on the lake; and

Whereas, Despite the perilous conditions, putting his own safety at risk, Brandon exhibited exceptional bravery, pushing through freezing water and ice to reach and rescue the second girl; and

Whereas, Thanks to Brandon's quick, heroic actions in this emergency situation, both girls were safely rescued, preventing what could have been a tragic outcome;
