

ORDINANCE NO. _____, SERIES 2023

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ~~\$5,000~~ ~~\$7,500~~ \$12,000 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$5,000 FROM DISTRICT 1; \$1,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 7, 8, AND 13; AND \$500 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 2, 3, 9, 10, 12, AND 14, 17, AND 19; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO SOUTHWEST FAMILY MINISTRIES, INC. FOR A PART-TIME MANAGER, TRANSPORTATION COSTS, AND ELECTRICITY COSTS FOR THE EXODUS COMMUNITY RESOURCE CENTER (AS AMENDED).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of ~~\$5,000~~ ~~\$7,500~~ \$12,000 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$5,000 from District 1; \$1,000 each from Districts 7, 8, and 13; and \$500 each from Districts 2, 3, 9, 10, 12, and 14, 17, and 19; through the Office of Management and Budget, to Southwest Family Ministries, Inc. for a part-time manager, transportation costs, and electricity costs for the Exodus Community Resource Center.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
