A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT \$250,000.00 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION THROUGH THE HIGHWAY INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND ASSETS. (AMENDMENT BY SUBSTITUTION)

SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBERS PURVIS AND ARTHUR

WHEREAS, this funding will be used to rehabilitate sidewalks, remove barriers to accessibility, improve modal choice, and enhance pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, this funding was secured to aid areas with high concentrations of households without vehicles and with a high number of pedestrian injuries occurring in close proximity to schools; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works and Assets has identified the need for sidewalk and curb repairs in Districts 4 and 5 on Broadway between 22nd Street and 47th Street which meets the funding criteria; and

WHEREAS, the Metro Government wishes to take advantage of this opportunity through the Department of Public Works and Assets.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept \$250,000.00 from the U.S. Department of Transportation through the Highway Infrastructure Program to be administered by the Department of Public Works and Assets.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
