**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT \$250,000.00 OF FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE THROUGH THE YOUTH VIOLENCE PREVENTION GRANT PROGRAM TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE OFFICE FOR SAFE AND HEALTHY NEIGHBORHOODS.**

**SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBER BRENT ACKERSON**

**WHEREAS**, the Youth Violence Prevention grant program provides resources, leadership, and solutions to advance community safety, build community trust, and strengthen the community's role as co-producer of safety and justices; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds will be used by the Office for Safe and Healthy Neighborhoods' Secondary Gang Prevention program to hire a specialist to serve as the coordinator of the city's collective impact approach to reduce youth gang recruitment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Metro Government wishes to take advantage of this opportunity through the Office for Safe and Healthy Neighborhoods.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept \$250,000.00 of funding from The Office of Justice grant program, to be administered by the Office for Safe and Healthy Neighborhoods.

**SECTION II:** This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
