A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT \$122,950.00 IN FUNDING FROM THE KENTUCKY OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR ENAHNCING PROTECTION OF SOFT TARGETS/OVERCROWDED AREAS THROUGH THE USE OF LICENSE PLATE READERS TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE LOUISVILLE METRO POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, The Kentucky Office of Homeland Security Grant program provides mitigative guidance to the public and private sectors against potential attacks by providing funding for the monitoring of threats, vulnerability assessments, and suspicious activity intelligence gathering and analysis;

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to protect the city's soft targets and overcrowded areas by providing automatic license plate reader equipment for physical security enhancements at the Louisville Muhammad Ali International Airport (SDF), Bowman Field (LOU), and Louisville Renaissance South Airport Business Park; and

WHEREAS, Metro Government wishes to take advantage of this opportunity through the Louisville Metro Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept \$122,950.00 in funding from the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security for enhancing public protection using automatic license plate readers to be administered by the Louisville Metro Police Department.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
