**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT \$397,090.11 OF FUNDING FROM THE KENTUCKY OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO STRENGTHEN CAPABILITIES NECESSARY TO PREVENT AND RESPOND TO ACTS OF TERRORISM TO BE ADMINISTERED BY EMERGENCY SERVICES.**

**SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBER BRENT ACKERSON**

**WHEREAS,** The State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) assists states to build, sustain, and deliver capabilities necessary to prevent, prepare for, protect against, and respond to acts of terrorism;

**WHEREAS,** these funds will be used to strengthen the city's terroristic preparedness by supporting anti-ram vehicle barriers, providing a sufficient level of mitigation from vehicle-borne threats to a secured area; and

**WHEREAS,** Metro Government wishes to take advantage of this opportunity through Emergency Services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept \$397,090.11 of funding from the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security to strengthen capabilities necessary to prevent and respond to acts of terrorism to be administered by Emergency Services.

**SECTION II:** This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
