**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT \$150,000.00 OF FUNDING FROM THE PUBLIC HEALTH INSTITUTE, CENTER FOR HEALTH LEADERSHIP AND IMPACT, FOR STRENGTHENING ENVIRONMENTAL LEAD-FREE COMMUNITIES BY DEVELOPING AND IMPLEMENTING LEAD-FREE STRATEGIES, TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELLNESS.**

**WHEREAS,** The Center for Health Leadership and Impact grant program provides funding to advance health and equity by increasing the capacity to transcend boundaries, work collaboratively, and transform communities; and

**WHEREAS,** these funds will be used to continue participation in the National Center for Environmental Health's Lead-Free Communities (LFC) by developing an LFC action plan and implementing selected intervention strategies from the LFC Toolkit; and

**WHEREAS,** Metro Government wishes to take advantage of this opportunity through the Department of Public Health and Wellness.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept \$150,000.00 of funding from the Public Health Institute, Center for Health Leadership and Impact, grant program to establish environmental lead-free communities by developing and implementing lead-free strategies.

**SECTION II:** This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
