Agency Testimony:

00:47:09 Dante St. Germain presented the applicant's proposal for a motel with 50 rooms. St. Germain established that the access easement is shared with a neighboring business.

00:50:56 Commissioner Mims clarified if the access easement has a sufficient width. Dante St. Germain agreed.

00:52:05 Commissioner Sistrunk acknowledged the legal description. Dante St. Germain elaborated that the access easement is 30 feet wide with 20 feet of frontage on Clay Avenue and 10 feet on the neighboring business.

00:52:50 Commissioner Sistrunk questioned the Preston Highway side. Dante St. Germain confirmed that there is no defined easement, and the access is on Clay Avenue.

00:53:19 Commissioner Carlson clarified if the fire department has seen the plan. Dante St. Germain confirmed that the Okolona Fire Protection District has not responded. St. Germain acknowledged that Louisville Metro Emergency Services recommended an address and name change of the access easement.

01:04:04 Nick Pregliasco confirmed that a 7-foot wooden fence is for screening.

01:07:08 Commissioner Mims clarified if the access easement on Preston Highway can connect to Clay Avenue. Nick Pregliasco agreed to change the development plan from L shaped to straight.

01:08:34 Commissioner Carlson offered a different material for the fence. Nick Pregliasco agreed.

01:09:36 Commissioner Carlson clarified if the fence is 7 or 8 feet. Dante St. Germain confirmed that C-1 is 8 feet and OTF is 7 feet. Nick Pregliasco acknowledged the change from C-1 to OTF and agreed to 8 feet.
