This is to transfer \$43,673.92 of District 13's Capital Infrastructure Fund to Louisville Metro Parks for improvements at Nelson Hornbeck Park. The funding will pay for a baseball storage building, concrete pad for the storage building and some other improvements. Currently, there is \$293,750.13 across four Nelson Hornbeck accounts. The project total is \$337,424.05 and the \$43,673.92 will bridge the gap to pay for all the improvements. Nelson Hornbeck is owned by Metro Parks and open to the public.
